**3rd ANNUAL COMMUNITY TALENT SHOW TO BENEFIT
THE LET IT BE FOUNDATION**

Chino Hills, CA — The Let It Be Foundation is holding open auditions for this year's "Kids 4 Kids" Community Talent Show to showcase the talent of Chino Valley elementary schoolchildren while supporting local families with children suffering from life-threatening illnesses.

It's the first time the foundation will take applications from individual schoolchildren to audition for the show, which will be held at Wickman Elementary School in Chino Hills on April 22-24. To qualify for an audition, you must attend a Chino Valley elementary school (public or private) and have an age-appropriate act that lasts no more than three minutes. Open audition applications will be available on March 14, from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. at Chik-fil-A at 3640 Grand Ave. in Chino Hills. Applications also are available online at theletitbefoundation.com. Auditions are scheduled for March 25.

As in past years, several elementary schools also will be selecting student acts for the show. Participating schools include: Briggs, Butterfield Ranch, Chaparral, Cortez, Country Springs, Eagle Canyon, Glenmeade, Howard Cattle, Litel, Loving Savior, Rhodes, and Wickman.

Tickets will be available at participating schools for \$5 each. Tickets also will be available at the door for \$5, but presales are strongly suggested. Concessions will be available at 5 p.m. each night, and the show will begin at 6 p.m.

The show is being organized by The Let It Be Foundation's Junior Advisory Team, which consists of Chino Valley junior high and high school students. All profits from the show will be used by the Junior Advisory Team to redecorate the bedrooms of children in the community who have life-threatening medical conditions. The Junior Advisory team has helped to provide room makeovers for six children in the community.

"This show gives us an opportunity to celebrate the wonderfully talented children we have in our community," said Ruthe Rosen, foundation president. "And the money we raise goes directly into room makeovers for the children we serve."

The Let It Be Foundation also will be accepting applications for the 2009-2010 Junior Advisory Team from April 1 to May 1. Applications are available online at theletitbefoundation.com.
