THE LET IT BE FOUNDATION SETS 3RD ANNUAL 5K-PLUS WALK-RUN

Chino Hills, CA — "Ready or Not!" is the slogan for The Let It Be Foundation's third annual 5K-Plus Walk-Run, scheduled for Saturday, May 2. Last year's event attracted over 1,300 participants and raised **\$43,000** to benefit the foundation's goal of providing support for Chino Valley families with children suffering from life-threatening illnesses.

The non-timed event will begin at 8 a.m. at Chino Hills High School, 6150 Pomona Rincon Rd., and will end with a pancake breakfast for participants. The route will cover trails and roads in the southern section of Chino Hills and near Chino Hills State Park.

"We've had the privilege of caring for 18 families since we launched our foundation," said Mrs. Rosen, who started the foundation with her after her 15-year-old daughter, Karla Asch-Rosen, died of a brain tumor in 2006. "We're so thankful that we've been able to bring the community together through events like this while, at the same time, helping families who are facing one of life's most difficult journeys." The foundation has provided families with home maintenance, groceries, clothing, school supplies, and transportation assistance.

The event, which is supported by the City of Chino Hills, is open to individuals and groups of all ages. Pre-registration entry fees are: \$30 for individuals; \$100 for families (up to 5 members); and \$25 per person for groups and clubs with 10 or more members. After April 16, registration fees will increase by \$5 per person and to \$125 for families.
