The Teams

The **Jr. Advisory Team** is a volunteer-focused leadership program of The Let It Be Foundation, which currently serves Chino Valley (Chino, Chino Hills and South Ontario). The team consists of fifteen 9th - 12th grade students that meet every 2nd and 4th Monday of the month in addition to other team activities.

The **Jr. Links Team**, consisting of eight 7th - 8th grade students, is an extension of the Jr. Advisory Team and meets every 4th Monday of the month in addition to other team activities.

The program's primary goal is to develop youth leaders with a philanthropic focus. All members, as a group, organize and execute various events to inspire their peers and other youth to get involved in their community. Each year, the Teams complete at least one room enhancement project for a family being cared for by the Foundation. Both teams meet on a monthly basis for developing key life skills, planning events and coordinating youth volunteer opportunities. The program is a one season commitment from July—May.

Age Requirements

All applicants for the Jr. Links Team must be entering 7th or 8th grade at the beginning of the team season. All applicants for the Jr. Advisory Team must be entering or already in high school at the beginning of the team season.

Team Fees

The team fee is \$95 per season. The fee includes a one-day leadership seminar, Foundation attire, notebook with program materials, and a minimum of (5) meals. Scholarship are available for financial assistance.
