GOLFERS BRAVE STORM TO RAISE RECORD SETTING FUNDS FOR THE LET IT BE FOUNDATION

Chino Hills, CA — Despite pouring rain and hail, The Let It Be Foundation's second annual golf tournament brought over 140 golfers of all ages together for a day on the course at the Los Serranos Golf & Country Club in Chino Hills.

The non-profit foundation, which provides support to Chino Valley families with children suffering from life-threatening illnesses, raised \$50,000 during the Monday (Feb. 9) event.

Along with the 110 adults and 31 youth, 18 members of the golf teams from Ayala, Don Lugo, Chino, and Chino Hills high schools participated, as did members of several area firefighter and police agencies. The storm let up just before the golfers hit the course in the afternoon.

Ayala High School golf team member Brayden Holland was awarded a \$500 scholarship for the school's golf program after his team won the youth scramble.

"It was amazing to see how many golfers showed up in the pouring rain, hanging onto hope that they would be able to golf," said foundation President Ruthe Rosen. "This, once again, is a testimony of how much our community supports our cause – helping families when *they* are living *their* biggest storms."
