#### **Youth Program Mission**

As a team, we bring awareness to life-threatening pediatric illnesses through various fundraising events, while inspiring other youth in the community to get involved.

The program's primary goal is to develop student leaders with a philanthropic focus while helping them master key life skills. All members interact with and enrich the lives of children diagnosed with pediatric cancer and other life-threatening illnesses. Team members, as a group, organize and execute various events focused on fundraising and awareness building in order to inspire their peers to get involved in their community. Both teams meet on a monthly basis to plan events and coordinate youth volunteer opportunities. The program is a one season commitment from July 2024 – May 2025.

#### **The Teams**

The **Jr. Advisory Team** is a volunteer-focused leadership program of *The Let It Be Foundation*. The team consists of  $10^{th} - 12^{th}$  grade students who <u>meet the second and fourth Monday of each month</u> and who also participate in additional team activities.

The **Jr. Links Team** is an extension of the Jr. Advisory Team. The team consists of 7<sup>th</sup>-9<sup>th</sup> grade students who meet every 2nd Monday of the month and who also participate in additional team activities.

#### **Grade Requirements**

Applicants for the Jr. Links Team must be entering 7th, 8th, or 9th grade at the beginning of the team season. All applicants for the Jr. Advisory Team must be entering 10<sup>th</sup> or 11<sup>th</sup> grade. First time applicants entering 12<sup>th</sup> grade are not eligible.

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#### **Team Fees**

The team fee is \$125\* per season. This fee includes a Foundation attire, program materials, meals at team events, and an end of season banquet.
